

## SUNDAY, JUNE 18, 2017 - WELCOME TO HOPE!

You are visiting us today, welcome! We look forward to getting to know you and walking alongside you in your journey with God. Please introduce yourself to someone near you and/or to one of our staff who will be available near the Welcome Booth after the service. **GIVING.** For those who would like to worship God by giving, there are two offering boxes near the Tech Booth in the back. **PRAYER.** Every Sunday, a group meets in the Sky Box from 10:00 – 10:15 am to pray for the service and for everyone who attends. We encourage anyone who is interested to join for prayer.

**NURSERY.** Parents with babies are free to use the Baby Sky Box (in the lobby). Nursery care for infants to age 3 is also provided during the service in the West Wing.

**CHILDREN.** All children who participate in Children's Ministry need to be checked in at one of the kiosks in the front lobby. They will receive a label that should be worn in plain view. Kids between ages 3 and 5<sup>th</sup> grade will remain with adults for the first part of our worship service. Parents, when the children are dismissed from the Sanctuary, please accompany your preschool-age children to the Children's Ministry wing. Kids 1<sup>st</sup>-5<sup>th</sup> grade may meet the Children's Ministry volunteer at the back of the Sanctuary. All children should be picked up by their parents at the end of the service.
