PRAYER. Every Sunday, a group meets in the Sky Box from 10:15 – 10:30 am to pray for the service and for everyone who attends. We encourage anyone who is interested to join for prayer.

#### **KIDS**

CHILDREN. All children who participate in Kids' Ministry need to be checked in at one of the kiosks in the front lobby. They will receive a label that should be worn in plain view. Kids between ages 3 and 5<sup>th</sup> grade will remain with the adults for the first part of our worship service. Parents, when the children are dismissed from the Sanctuary, please accompany your preschool-age children to the Kids' Ministry wing. Kids 1<sup>st</sup>-5<sup>th</sup> grade may meet the Kids' Ministry volunteer at the back of the Sanctuary. All children should be picked up by their parents at the end of the service.

NURSERY. Parents with babies are free to use the Baby Sky Box (in the balcony). Nursery care for infants to age 3 is also provided during the service in the West Wing.
